INDEPENDENT STUDENT STATUS REQUIREMENTS

Requirement for admission and continued enrollment of independent individuals.

- A. An independent person who is at least eighteen (18) but under twenty-two (22) years of age may be admitted to Girard City School District is s/he:
 - 1. Lives in the District apart from his/her parents.
 - 2. Supports himself/herself by his/her own labor.
 - 3. Has not been granted a high school diploma or certificate of attendance.

- B. Prior to admission, such students must:
 - 1. Provide documentation of residence per Board Policy 10-060.
 - 2. Document at least sixty (60) days of continuous employment.
 - 3. Provide a personal budget documenting that income from employment meets or exceeds expenses.
 - 4. Provide a statement from his/her employer with the student's work schedule so it will not conflict with the student's school schedule.
 - 5. Complete Student Residency/Enrollment Form and show proof of required documents.
 - 6. Sign the Independent Student Residency Affidavit.

- C. After admission, such students must:
 - 1. Attend school regularly with no more than fifteen (15) days of absence during each school year.
 - 2. No later than the fifteenth (15th) day of each month document continued employment by providing copies of pay vouchers for the previous month.
